### **MACLA's Mission Statement**

MACLA is an energizing contemporary arts space where Latino artists create and showcase new work in the visual, literary, and performance arts to help define, interpret, and transform society.

In order to be considered for an exhibition at MACLA, we request a packet with the following:

1. Digital images (jpeg, tif or eps) of the artist's work on DVD
2. A statement about the work
3. A biography of the artist
4. An artist resume

We schedule our exhibitions 12-18 months in advance and offer only one solo show per year. We look to feature artists who have a developed body of work around a particular theme or themes. As an alternative Latino arts space, we are particularly interested in featuring work that utilizes video, installation, and new media, and/or deals with themes of particular urgency in today's society: labor, politics, gender, identity, sexuality, globalization, etc. Artists whose concepts are as well developed as the execution of the work are favorably received. If your work is aligned with MACLA's standards, you will be invited to participate in our "invite-only" Annual Latino Art Auction which occurs each spring. Once your work is on file at MACLA, you will be considered for inclusion in future group exhibitions.
